Heathrow Airport

- o Heathrow Express Train to Paddington Rail Station. London Underground Circle Line to South Kensington then change to Piccadilly Line to Hyde Park Corner.
- o Heathrow Express Train to Paddington Rail Station. London Underground Bakerloo Line to Piccadilly Circus then change to Piccadilly Line to Hyde Park Corner.
- o London Underground Piccadilly Line from Heathrow Airport to Hyde Park Corner.

Gatwick Airport

- o Gatwick Express from South Terminal to Victoria Train Station. London Underground Circle Line to South Kensington then change to Piccadilly Line to Hyde Park Corner.
- o Train from Gatwick South Terminal to London Bridge Station. London Underground Jubilee Line to Green Park then change to Piccadilly Line to Hyde Park Corner.

Victoria Bus Station

- o London Underground Circle Line from Victoria to South Kensington, then change to Piccadilly Line to Hyde Park Corner.

Paddington Rail Station

- o London Underground Circle Line from Paddington to South Kensington, then change to Piccadilly Line to Hyde Park Corner.

Euston Rail Station

- o London Underground Victoria Line from Euston to Green Park, then change to Piccadilly Line to Hyde Park Corner.

Car Parking

- o The Caledonian Club has negotiated discount parking at NCP Cadogan Place Car Park. In order to receive the discount, a pre-loaded card is required which may be obtained from Reception. Charges after the discount are £8.25 per hour and £36 for 24 hours. Free street parking: 18.30-8.30, after 13.00 Saturday and all-day Sunday.
